Definitions

Equitation – Class is judged on Rider's Performance

Pleasure – Class is judged on Horse's Performance

Hunter – Class is judged on Horse's Performance

Gambler's Choice – Each rider has 60 seconds to jump as many jumps as possible.

Jumper – Each rider who completes a clean round will be invited back to ride again in a shortened course.

Proper riding attire required: Polo shirt or riding shirt, breeches or jodhpurs, riding boots, jackets (if desired), or ASTM approved helmet.

At the discretion of the event coordinator, judge, or operations manager classes can be divided, combined or scratched.

All decisions made by judges are final.

Rider entered in walk trot only classes are not eligible to enter in ANY walk, trot, and canter classes but can compete in jumping classes.

2009 Negative Coggins is required for all horses!

Classes are \$10.00 each.
Places 1st – 6th are pinned for each class.
